Public Masses will begin at St. Francis of Assisi Church on Wednesday 15th July. We will be following Government Guidelines and meeting the following requirements:

- Wearing face masks prior to entering the church building. (exceptions for people with health conditions and under 5 Y.O.)
- Sanitising hands when entering & leaving using gel provided at Church entrance.
- Maintaining safe (2m) distancing.
- Limiting attendance per service to a maximum of 50 people including volunteers/welcomers. This will be reviewed on the 30th July
- Maintaining contact details of all attendees for each service.
- Seats and pews to be cleaned/sanitised after every Mass.
- A one-way system is in place for doors and isles, all exit (except for any with mobility issues) will be via the hall row by row.

New Mass Timetable & Church Opening Times

Monday to Saturday : 10.00 AM ; Sunday : 11.00 AM & 6.00 PM

The church will be open for one hour after each mass for those who are shielding and would be comfortable to visit at a quieter time for personal prayer and to receive holy communion.

General Guidelines, points to note

- Registration will include giving your name and contact details. This is for contact tracing purposes.
- Church doors will open 15 minutes before the service, please arrive in good time.
- All unused tickets/seats will be given to 'Walk-ins' 5 minutes before the Mass begins so please arrive in good time and be seated
- Holy water is placed in small bottles at the entrance, please take one per family.
- There will be no congregational singing and no hymn books provided. Cantors may contribute.
- There will be no offertory procession of gifts of bread and wine.
- No offertory collection plate will be passed around, so please put your gift aid envelopes/offerings in the basket at the entrance. Those who are yet to sign up
